 Most areas of the Park will be open with modifications. Due to public health and safety concerns, some locations and facilities are **closed**.
 Glacier Point Road, Wawona Road (Hwy 41), Big Oak Flat Road, Hetch Hetchy Road (8am-5pm), El Portal Road (Hwy 140), Tioga Pass, and Mariposa Grove Road are all **OPEN**. (Mariposa Grove Road hike in or bike in only)
 Hazardous tree removal along Glacier Point Road starts 7/6/2020, work will continue throughout the summer, please anticipate delays.
 Dead/down tree and biomass removal on Goat Meadow Road from Grizzly Giant parking lot to park/forest boundary, and Goat Meadow Road; avoid area
 Hazardous tree removal along Tioga Road from Yosemite Creek to the west, and road work between May Lake Rd - Tioga Pass; Mon-Thurs, expect delays
 Restoration Project at Stoneman Bridge from 8/17 - 11/19; expect delays

From a Sequoia/Kings Canyon Website (nps.gov/seki): Sequoia & Kings Canyon NPS facilities, including some campgrounds, visitor centers, restaurants and lodging are **temporarily closed** to all visitors until further notice.

 Entrance stations, roads, parking lots, and restrooms throughout both parks are open. Campgrounds to open 7/6/20, Potwisha, Lodgepole, & Sunset, must book on recreation.gov (reservations go live Monday, June 29th).

Backpackers Campground: Temporarily relocated to the back loop of Upper Pines (sites 188-240).

Fire Restrictions:

Stage 2 fire restrictions, NO campfires, charcoal stove, and cigarette smoking at all elevations except in designated campgrounds, picnic,

Bike Rentals:	and residential areas. Yosemite Lodge - open 8am - 6pm
Raft Rentals:	Curry Village - open 8am - 6pm Closed for the season Please go to traveleyosemite.com/alerts/2020/covid-19-guest-updates/ for further information regarding what is open/closed in the park.
Park Shuttle Buses:	Not operating this summer.
Mariposa Grove:	Walk-in from the Depot area or bicycle only (eBikes okay), no bicycles on trails. ADA placard vehicles allowed to park in upper parking lot.
CLOSED AREAS:	Mist Trail from the top of Vernal Fall to the John Muir Trail junction near the Vernal Fall footbridge is closed to downhill hiking from 9am-4pm daily. Use Clark Point cutoff trail & JMT. Lwr Yosemite Fall boulders (between footbridge/viewing area & waterfall). Bridalveil Fall area (closed due to scheduled maintenance work). Crane Flat Helibase & Chowchilla Mtn Road (on NPS website).
