 Glacier Point Road, Wawona Road (Hwy 41), Big Oak Flat Road, Hetch Hetchy Rd (8am-5pm), El Portal Rd (Hwy 140), and Tioga Pass Rd **OPEN**.
 Mariposa Grove Road is **CLOSED**
 Glacier Point Road: Hazardous tree removal M-Th until further notice; expect delays.
 Big Oak Flat: Road work from the park boundary working towards the east, M-Th, 7AM-3:30PM; expect delays.

Sequoia/Kings Canyon

Sequoia & Kings Canyon National Parks are **OPEN** with exception to the Mineral King area and some wilderness lands due to wildfire concerns. Entrance stations, roads, parking lots, and restrooms are **OPEN**. Up to 1 hour delay on Generals Highway due to road construction. Wuksachi Lodge, John Muir Lodge and Grant Grove Cabins are **OPEN**. Potwisha and Lodgepole campgrounds are **OPEN**; must book on recreation.gov
