THE FOLLOWING SECTORS ARE NOW ALLOWED INDOORS:

- **TK-12 SCHOOLS** 
LOCAL SCHOOL OFFICIALS MAY DECIDE TO FULLY RE-OPEN FOR
IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION
- **GYMS/FITNESS CENTERS** 
AT 10% CAPACITY
- **RESTAURANTS** 
AT 25% CAPACITY
- **MOVIE THEATRES** 
AT 25% CAPACITY*
- **MUSEUMS, ZOOS, & AQUARIUMS** 
AT 25% CAPACITY

ALLOWED INDOORS:

- **PLACES OF WORSHIP**
25% CAPACITY
- **RETAIL**
50% CAPACITY
- **PERSONAL CARE**
50% CAPACITY
- **HAIR SALONS & BARBERSHOPS**



ALLOWED OUTDOORS:

- WINERIES AND TASTING ROOMS
- FAMILY ENTERTAINMENT CENTERS
- CARDROOMS/SATELLITE WAGERING
- LIVE EVENTS W/ AUDIENCE 
20% CAPACITY (EFFECTIVE APRIL 1)

NOT YET ALLOWED TO RESUME

- **BARS**
- **NIGHTCLUBS**
- **BOWLING ALLEYS**
- **SAUNAS AND STEAM ROOMS**

As certain activities are allowed to resume, proceed with caution.

Remember: Just because it is allowed, it does not necessarily mean it is safe.

Vaccinations are occurring as quickly as supplies allow, but most people in our community are still not vaccinated.



The key to fewer restrictions is following public health measures.

Counties can move to a less restrictive tier as COVID transmission goes down and testing goes up.

Stay diligent. Wear a mask, keep your distance, and get vaccinated when it's your turn.
